Other Ingredients: Mannitol, Crospovidone, Stearic Acid, Flavor, Magnesium Stearate, Sucralose, Polyvinyl Acetate.

Suggested Usage: Under the supervision of a physician for dietary management of patients with chronic renal failure; uremia; impaired metabolic functions of the kidney; and to maintain nutrient levels when dietary intake of vitamins is inadequate or excretion or loss is excessive.

Precautions: Folic acid may mask the symptoms of pernicious anemia in that hematologic remission may occur while neurologic manifestations remain progressive.

Dosage and Administration: One tablet daily, or as directed by a physician. If on dialysis, take after treatment.
